


# NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION



Governor Jim Justice has called for a special election for voters to decide on a constitutional amendment. The Roads to Prosperity Amendment of 2017, if passed, would provide for the improvement and construction of safe roads in the state by the issuance of bonds not to exceed \$1.6 billion.

**The Special Election will take place on  
Saturday, October 7, 2017**  
Polls are open from 6:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m.

# QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

## About the October 7th Special Election

**How can I learn more about the Special Election and the “Roads to Prosperity” constitutional amendment?**

**When is the last day to register to vote?**

If you are not already registered to vote, the last day to register in order to participate in the Special Election is *Monday, September 18, 2017*.

**Can a 17-year old register to vote and participate in the Special Election?**

Only if the 17-year old will be 18-years old by October 7, 2017. If a 17-year old will not be 18-years old by October 7, 2017, then he or she should wait to register to vote until after the Special Election.

**Will early voting be permitted for the Special Election?**

Yes, early voting will take place from September 22 – October 4, 2017, in the County Courthouse or Annex. For more information, contact your county clerk.

**For this Special Election in October, will I vote in the same location where I usually vote?**

Not necessarily. Most polling locations will remain the same. However, it is not unusual for polling locations to be moved and/or combined for Special Elections. It is recommended that you contact your county clerk to be sure.

**I recently received a postcard in the mail asking about the status of my voter’s registration. What does that mean?**

Simply follow the instructions on the card to update your voter registration information. This can be done online at [ovr.sos.wv.gov](http://ovr.sos.wv.gov), by returning the postcard in the mail, or contacting your county clerk.

**If I wanted to be considered for a poll worker position, who should I contact?**

County clerks are always looking for individuals to work elections. To inquire about open positions and rates of pay, please contact your county clerk.
